COURSE 1

Course Title	European States Foreign Policy
Learning outcomes	<p>This course aims at presenting the diversity of European Foreign Policies. Each European State presents specific features in its political, diplomatic and economic preferences and cooperation, within both within outside the European Union.</p> <p>Focus will be given on :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The origin of this diversity : religions, political traditions and systems, geopolitical constraints ; - The impact on Foreign Policies of the EU member countries and their challenges for the European Political Construction.
Pre-requisites	Fundamentals of World History and Geopolitical Challenges

The course will be composed of 24h of face to face: lectures and tutorials.

COURSE 2

Course Title	International Negotiations : Narrative & Diplomacy
Learning outcomes	<p>By the end of the course, students shall be able to :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To gather information to write diplomatic note on international political and economic concerns ; - To analyze political discourses and interviews given by Heads of States & ministers of foreign policy ; - Participate in roleplays, playing the part of a E.U. state official (mission – project – objectives)
Pre-requisites	Fundamentals of World History and Geopolitical Challenges

COURSE CONTENT:

The course will be composed of 16h of face to face: lectures,tutorials and roleplay (a EU summit).

COURSE 3 OVERVIEW:

Course Title	International Negotiations : Crisis and Conflict Resolution
Learning outcomes	<p>In this course, Students will learn about the mechanism of conflict, conflict prevention & management, conflict resolution & post-rehabilitation throughout a series of significant illustrative examples, such as anti-EU protests in Greece.</p> <p>By the end of the course, students shall be able to :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Identify the roots of crises and conflicts (inter/intra states);- Determine the main actors in conflict, management and resolution;- Select the policies and strategies for Peace building operations and implementations.

The course will be composed of 16h of face to face: lectures,tutorials and roleplay (a European crisis negotiation).

COURSE 4 OVERVIEW:

Course Title	European Union Contemporary Issues
Learning outcomes	<p>In the recent years, the E.U. has gone through a series of political, economic and migratory crises, resulting in political tensions (Ukraine and Russia), economic turmoil (Greece and the Eurocrisis), the rise of populism and independantist movements, the Brexit and the question of state legitimacy.</p> <p>By the end of the course, students shall be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Identify the different E.U. crises▪ Develop reflexion on the E.U. crises potential impact on the E.U. integration process
